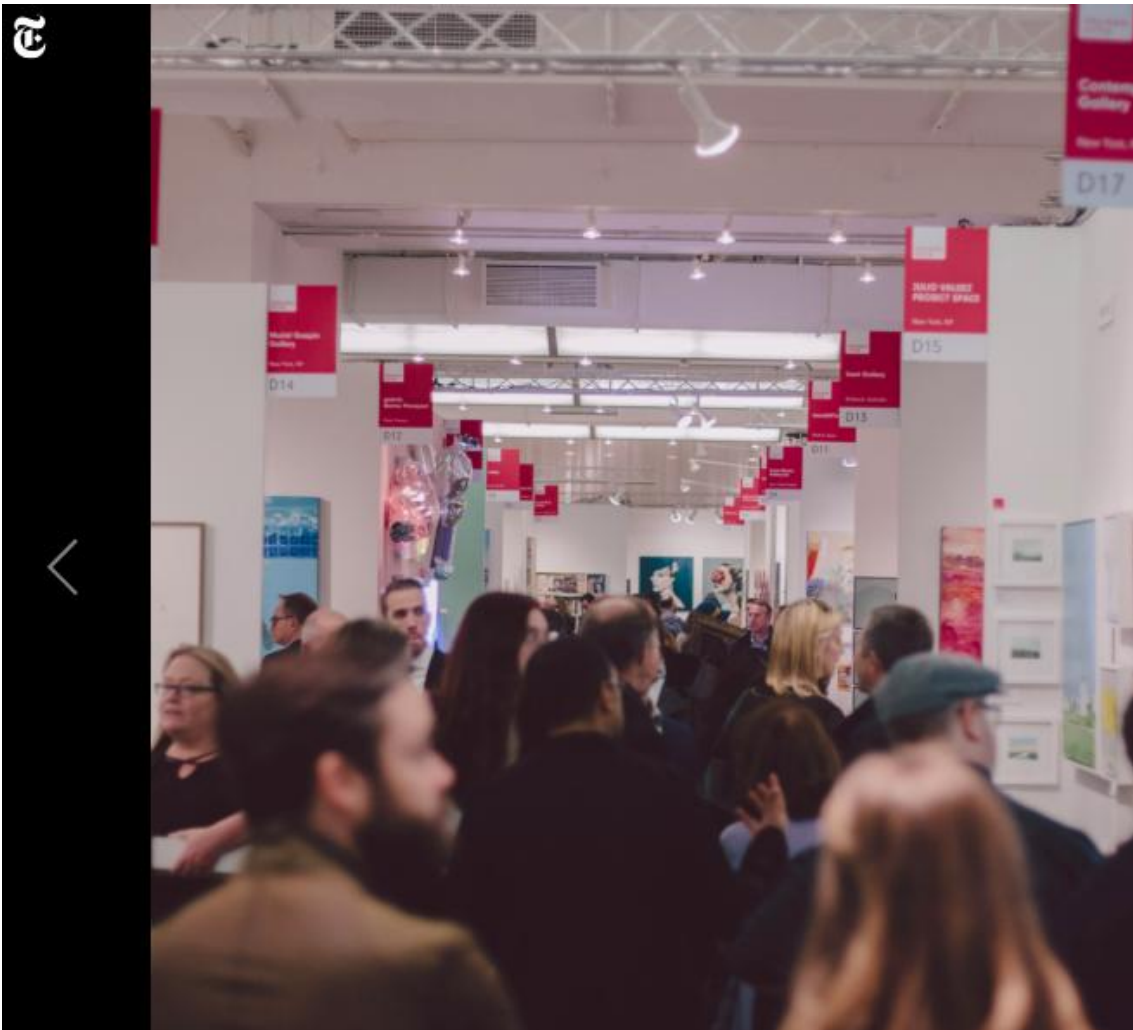




# Inexpensive Inspiration at the Affordable Art Fair NYC
