InSight Artspace Presents "Humanity and Nature" at Context Art Miami, December 2025

Miami, FL, December 2-7, 2025 – InSight Artspace is thrilled to announce its participation in CONTEXT Art Miami, one of the most prestigious art fairs of Miami Art Week. CONTEXT Art Miami is dedicated to the development and reinforcement of emerging and mid-career artists and sister fair to Art Miami, also running from December 2 through 7, 2025.

For this edition, Catherine Testorf, owner of InSight Artspace, will proudly present "Humanity and Nature" at Booth B2 with a collection of works encouraging reflection on the connection between humans and their surroundings – in contrast with last year's exhibition, "Femininity." Exhibiting artists include:



• Beatrice Bizot uses architectural forms and sculptural faces as a language to express the intricacies of the feminine experience. This deep interconnection between structure and fragility, permanence and transformation, reflects a relationship between human creation and the organic world. Through her art, Bizot reveals how the feminine experience mirror's nature's resilience and adaptability. This year, she was one of three artists selected to create a sculpture of Saint Roch for the Sagrada Familia Foundation in Barcelona.



• Carole Jury explores the emotional landscape that binds human emotion to the natural world as a photographer and abstract painter. Her *Humanity* series sees broad textured strokes and layered hues evoking raw power and delicate emotional balance; her canvases pulse with movement, from fiery reds that symbolize passion and vitality to tranquil blues that reflect the peace of still water and the sky. Through her dynamic interplay between color and texture, Jury captures the essence of tension between human feeling and natural rhythm.



• Anne De Villeméjane's ethereal figures are both fragile and powerful at the same time. Her work reflects the delicate balance of human nature, exuding a worldly energy while appearing as if in a dream. Recognized for her rare sensitivity and strong sense of color and textures, Anne De Villeméjane's passion for bronze began in 2000. From critical reviews and through her own rigor, Anne has developed a refined eye and hand for sculpture, forever experimenting with new materials such as bronze, metal, concrete, resin, and crystal.



• Esther Rosa combines her background as a psychologist and life coach into her artistic practice, effectively investigating the profound connections of self-awareness and personal development, and human consciousness. Rosa's exquisite paper clay abstractions illuminate both archetypal beauty and the radiance of imperfection, as a vital expression of life's beauty. Rosa's work invites viewers to embrace transformation and the shared vulnerability that unites humanity with the natural world, as a way to ground oneself in one's emotions. This marks her first participation at CONTEXT.



• Elsa Marie Keefe is a multidisciplinary American artist whose work spans across painting, photography, and mixed media to explore the essence of humanity and the natural world. Keefe's layered compositions evoke the delicate balance between vulnerability and transcendence, revealing how human emotion and environmental rhythm mirror one another. In her recent Florida series, she reflects on the body's spiritual and ecological connection to place, with key works such as Serendipity (seen here, fourth down) embodying moments of harmony in and around the human body and its living landscape.



• Nuria Formenti creates a deeply personal dreamlike world with intense colors shaping the organic flow of nature. Her unique expressive capacity of abstraction emerges in her watercolor stain maps, interwoven with ink threads and tiny textual inscriptions, resemble neural pathways, rivers of consciousness, psychic landscapes and constellations revealing the interconnectedness of thought and environment. Through her poetic compositions, Formenti showcases the parallels between natural systems and the mind's natural, chaotic terrain. This will be her first time exhibiting art in the United States.

Each artist brings a unique visual language, yet together their works echo a shared narrative of strength, empathy, and empowerment. Through this exhibition, InSight Artspace aims to spark conversation, increase awareness, and foster advocacy for gender equality in the art world.
